



2026 McMinnville Garden Faire Information Letter

Dear Garden Faire Vendors,

We are excited to be making preparations for Sunday Jun 14th. This is the basic information that you will need for the day of the Faire.

Last year's footprint will remain about the same. Allowing more visibility for both Customers and Vendors and allows us to space appropriately for everyone's safety. Please remember not to exceed the space that you requested.

Your space assignments will be emailed to you in June, when the Vendor map has been finalized. At that time, please locate your space and make some mental notes of how best to approach it for unloading purposes. Club members will be available to help direct traffic and answer questions.

We have several city parking lots in close proximity that we would like to keep open for customers, so use your best judgement when you select your own parking space. It always seems to work out fine, so not to worry.

The local Fire Department will be visiting us early Sunday morning to make sure we haven't created any unsafe conditions. They would like us to have multiple fire extinguisher sites and you can help by bringing a **currently serviced fire extinguisher**, with an unexpired tag, if you have one, and letting us know that you have it. We will give you a sign to display so that in the event it is needed, it can be easily located.

New All vendors who have tents or canopies must have a minimum of **20** pounds of weight to secured to each canopy leg. **40 pounds is suggested**. Each vendor is responsible for any fly away damages that might incur. **This is mandatory.**

Our official unloading time is 6:30 a.m. with an "open to the public start time" of 9:00 a.m. We will close at 4:00 p.m. so please do not start to dismantle your booth before then. We will have two porta-potties available when you arrive and at least one of the local restaurants will visit our area to take lunch orders, if you are interested. We will deliver bottled water to you several times during the day and if you are alone and need someone to keep an eye on your booth so you can take a short break, we can do that for you as well, just let us know.

There is absolutely **no vendor parking** in the Presbyterian Church Parking Lot from 9:00 until 12:00. You may use the lot to unload and later to pack up, however, the Church does use the lot during their Sunday services.

Our goal is to make your visit with us not only profitable, but also memorable. Call or email if you have any questions. See you Sunday June 14th, 2026!
